Bereavement

- 1. Support and Comfort of the Family: The family is assisted in obtaining information regarding funeral arrangements. The Social Worker can be a resource for any of these issues surrounding death, funeral arrangements or any family issues.
- 2. If there are siblings, personnel shall inquire if the parents need information or support in informing them of the death.
- 3. A properly accepted Advanced Directive will be followed.
- 4. A private area shall be provided for the family to spend time with their child.
- 5. Bereavement Care may include: spiritual/emotional/cultural support, bereavement packet (English and Spanish), guidance or logistical support with funeral arrangements, referral to community resources, provision of support group information, or referral to other healthcare team members.
